

Suggested Kit List

Below is a list of equipment and clothing we suggest you bring with you for your employment period with Rockley Watersports. For the staff members working in France, we would like to reiterate that you are living in tented accommodation – while we may be able to store small valuables and important documents (passports etc.) in our safes in the office, we suggest you leave any major valuables at home. Although to date security on our campsites has never been a problem, it's important to bear in mind that there is no method of locking your tents. From time to time in France, the heavens do open and things may get damp. Any of your possessions that may not like these conditions should stay at home!

Alarm Clock
Contract of Employment
EHIC Card (valid)
Euros – method of accessing your €'s while out in France
French plug adapter
Washing powder (there are washing machines on all the campsites)
Hat
High Factor Sun Cream & After Sun
Sailing knife, whistle & watch – For every staff member on activities they are a necessity.
Insurance (if not opting in to our Staff Services Package)
iPod – with headphones. A stereo system is not recommended - loud music is not permitted at any of the Rockley Watersports campsites.
Musical instruments
Off duty clothes
Passport valid for 3 months after you return to the UK.
Pillow with cover
Rash Vest (if owned)
Duvet with cover (or sleeping bag if contract is short)
Staff Handbook
Sunglasses
Swimming kit
Towels
Trainers
Warm jumpers and hoodies for the evening time
Wash Kit
Water Bottle
Waterproofs (if owned, a jacket at a minimum)
Wellies (a must for those doing montage)
Wet Suit (if owned – shortie or full length)
Wet suit shoes or other type of water shoes. Footwear must always be worn but flip-flops are not permitted when teaching.
